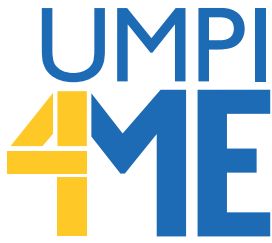


# Special Education Paraprofessional, A.A.
